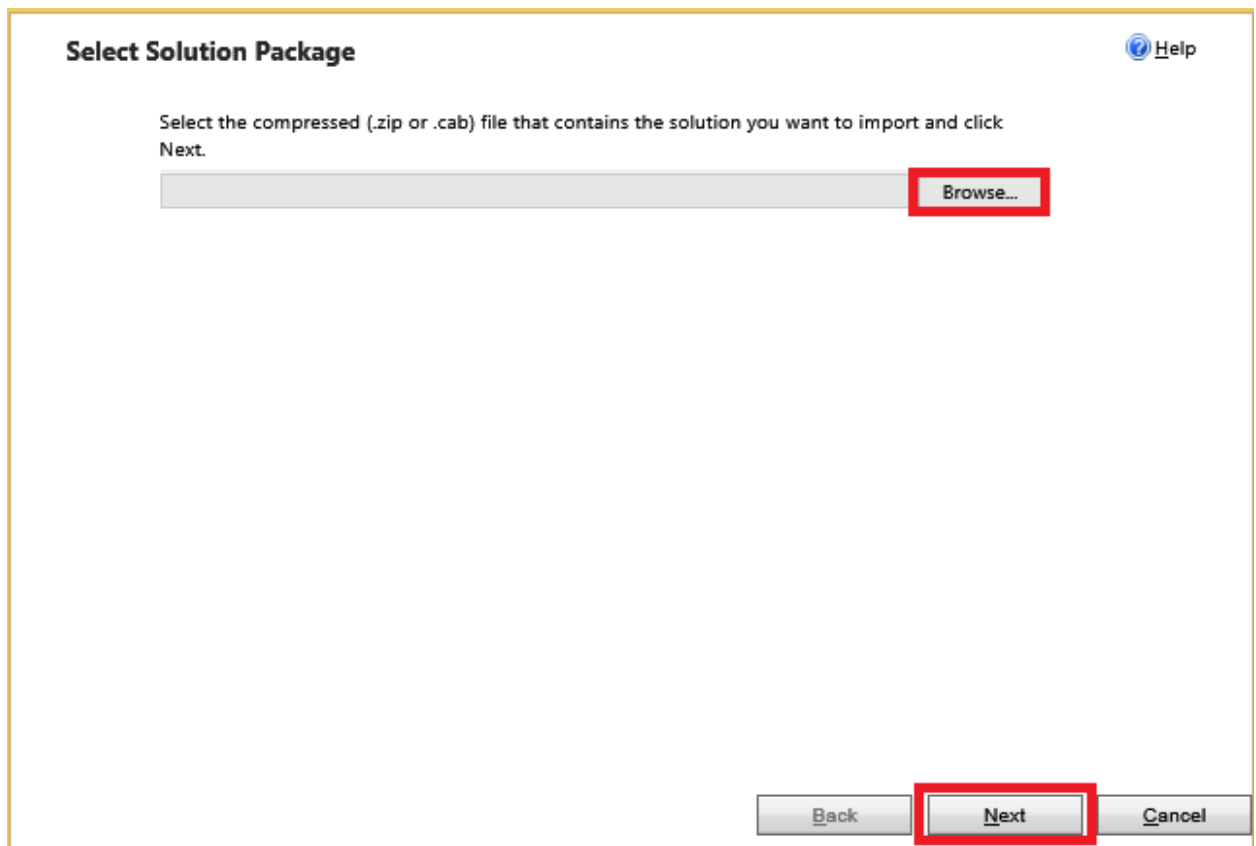

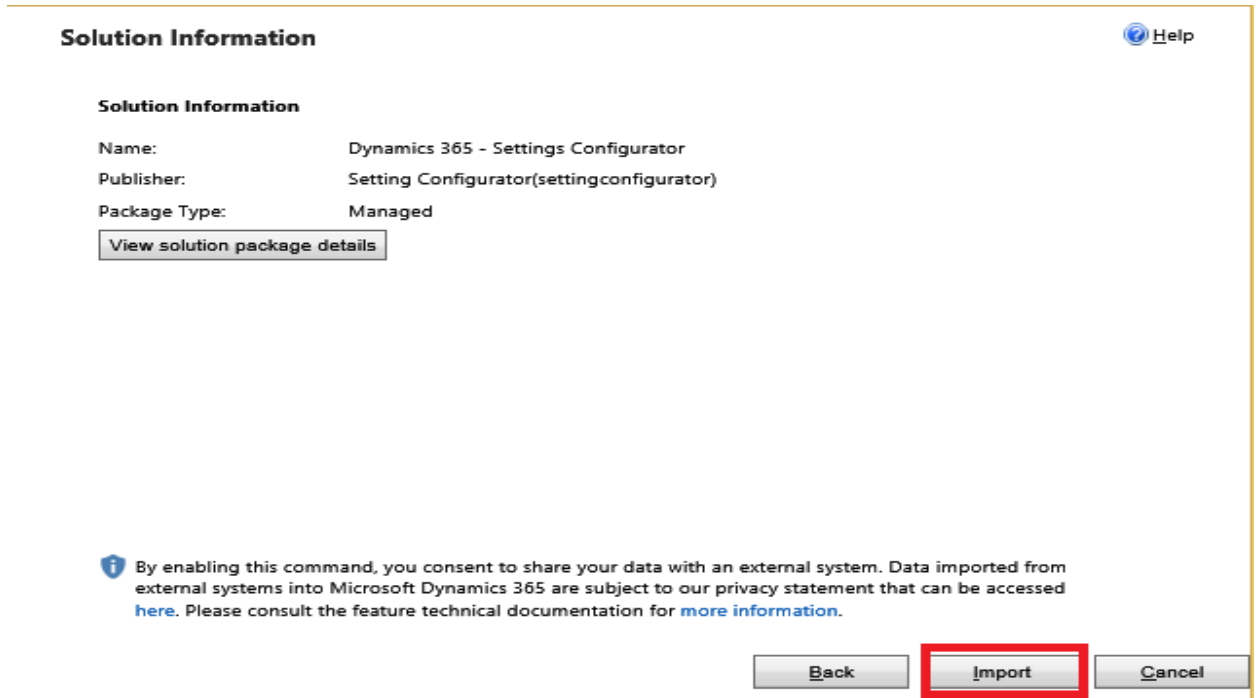
Import - Dynamics 365 - Settings Configurator Solution

The first step in getting started with any managed solution in Microsoft Dynamics CRM is to import the solution under the Solution section of CRM. To navigate to this section, you would simply go to Settings > Solutions > Select the Import button from the ribbon. This will prompt a dialog box that will walk you through the import process, which is shown below.

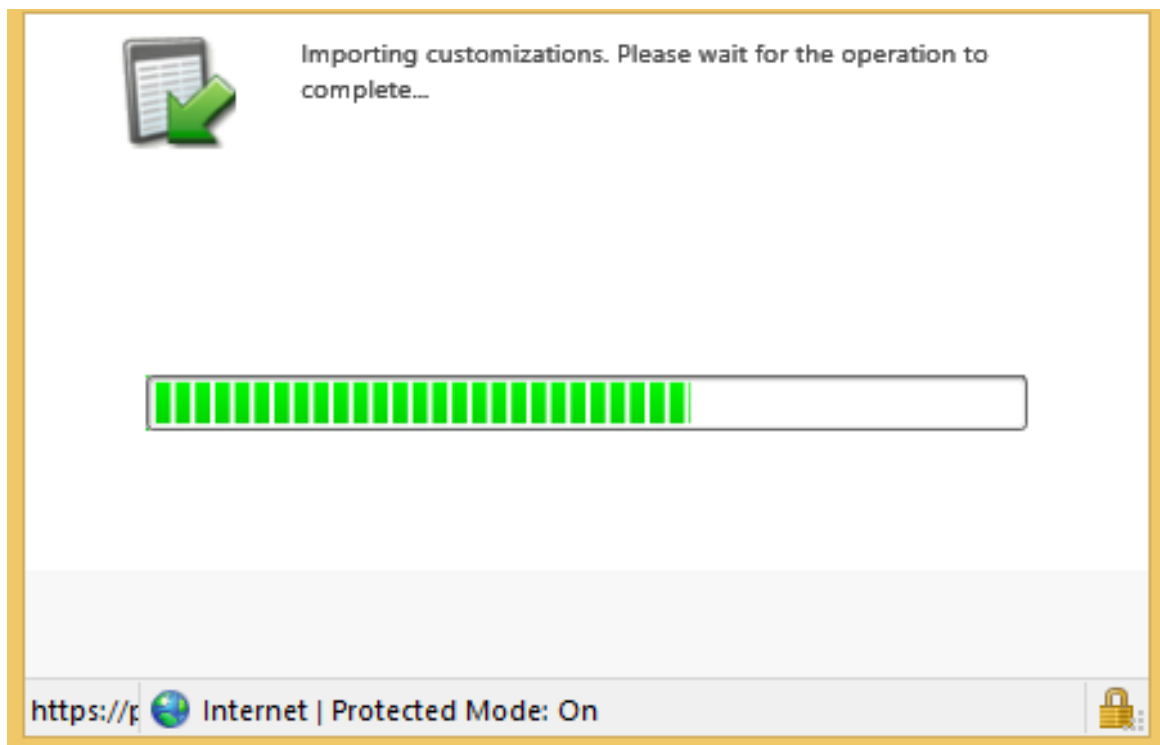
1. "Browse" and select the **Dynamics 365 - Settings Configurator** solution file that you have previously downloaded to your desktop, once the zip file is populated select "Next"



2. The next screen will verify you all the details of the solution that you are going to import and then select "Next" to move on as shown below.



3. Once you have clicked on Import button then a new window will appear showing you a progress bar for the import. This step will usually take 5 to 10 min



4. Once this solution import is success full then will view a screen with overview of the imported solution. Once done click on Close button.
